



Gender Action Ecofeminist Indicators:

In the 2000s Gender Action began developing, updating and adapting a set of ecofeminist indicators to analyze how IFI projects and policies impact women, LGBTQ+ people and climate together. Each time we analyze an IFI project or policy we update, improve and customize the indicators.

Below are recent examples of reports that apply our customized indicators. Titles are hyperlinked:

Women Stand their Ground against BIG Coal, prepared with [Lumière Synergie pour le Développement \(LSD\)](#) and the [WoMin African Alliance](#) in **2019** applied a subset of four broad indicators each containing several sub-indicators, to analyze and highlight deleterious impacts of the public African Development Bank (AfDB)-financed Sendou coal plant on people, particularly women, and ecosystems, amidst the world's intensifying climate emergency.

"Unmet Gender Promises: making IFI projects and policies deliver on gender-equal rights", co-sponsored by NGO Forum on ADB, Oxfam and Recourse in **2020** customized and applied about a dozen indicators to analyze and score an array of International Financial Institutions' (IFIs)' gender policies and the gender-sensitivity of their Environmental and Social Frameworks (ESFs).

More than an add-on? Evaluating the integration of gender in Green Climate Fund projects and programs, prepared with the Heinrich Böll Stiftung Washington DC in **2021** applied 27 indicators and sub-indicators to analyze the extent to which the GCF, the largest global multilateral climate fund, considers gender impacts of its funding portfolio.

IFIs' Rhetorical Gender & Climate Promises, co-sponsored by Friends of the Earth and Urgewald in **2023** customized and applied about a dozen indicators to update our "Unmet Gender Promises" analysis, scoring and ranking many International Financial Institutions' (IFIs)' gender policies and the gender-sensitivity of their Environmental and Social Frameworks (ESFs).
